

It borders Turkey, Armenia and Azerbaijan to the south. Russia & the Caucacus mountains to the North and the warm coastal resorts along the Black Sea to the West.








Georgia is a small country situated in the south of the Great Caucasus, between the Black and Caspian seas. Despite its size, it is the bearer of a rich cultural and traditional inheritance preserved over centuries and described in various myths and legends. The name of the country 'Georgia' is believed to be taken from the Persian word gorg which means 'land of wolves'. The history of Georgia goes back at least 3500 years and Christianity (the state religion) was adopted 2000 years ago.







Tbilisi Georgia Climate



The climate in Georgia is mild (23 degrees average) with some rain in the west & coastal area. while the central and western parts is warmer and drier(26 degrees average). In the mountains it's obviously cooler.




