Matilda and the Parrot


Task: Colour the parrot in the colours you think he was from the story 'Matilda', by Roald Dahl. Then, make the parrot following the instructions given.

Create a speech bubble for the parrot, writing in the bubble what you would have taught the parrot to say.






















Parrot Instructions



Step 1


Carefully cut out the model along the solid black outline. Carefully cut out around the feet and up along the wings as shown.



Step 2


Fold along the dotted lines as the diagram below shows, folding up and down accordingly.





Step 3


Glue tabs I and 2 to the chest of the parrot as shown.



Step 4


Fold tabs 3 and 4 down so they are flush with the body as shown.





Step 5

Glue tabs 5 and 6 to the top of the parrot's head as shown.



Step 6

Glue the wings to the back of the parrot using tabs 7 and 8 making sure the wings point towards the bottom of the model as shown.



Step 7

Glue the beak together using tabs 9 and 10 as shown.



Step 8

Glue the beak to the parrot's body using tabs 11 and 12 as shown.

Optional — Glue the parrot's feet to the base plate using tabs 13-16 to help the model stand on a ledge.
